Teamwork Makes the Dream Work

“Geil Kilns are workhorses that are robustly built and hold up to the demands of one of the largest academic ceramic studios in the country. The kilns were installed in the fall of 2016 after our school was rebuilt from a major flood of the arts campus in 2008. They require almost zero maintenance and are programmable to fire in reduction or oxidation environments that are repeatable and consistent. We have various sizes ranging from large car kilns to 10 cu. ft of stacking space, so that we can accommodate whatever work is done by our students and keep our workflow moving. These 7 Geil Kilns operate almost daily, serving the firing needs of 12 sections of ceramic classes every semester, as well as a cohort of 8 graduate students and 4 faculty members. Collectively we use over 20,000 lbs. of clay per semester.” -
