

**Workshop from Home with Jeremy Randall**  
**Resources for February 24, 2022**

- Jeremy's studio is about 950 sq ft., though he is moving to a new location in April that will be almost triple that size! He is looking to do more teaching out of his studio, and grow his apprenticeship program.
- He uses Laguna #20 clay, preferably with no grog.
- Jeremy bisque fires to 1880°F (1027°C) (cone 05) and glaze fires to 2030°F (1110°C) (between cone 02–01).
- All of Jeremy's color is derived from Mason Stain mixed into terra sigillata. He has some other slips that are used occasionally, but he mostly likes the versatility of Mason Stain.
- He has two preferred glazes: a white glaze and a black glaze.
- Jeremy uses slab building techniques to build his pots.
- His favorite tools are ones that he has modified as needed. A flexible blade Dolan knife, X-acto knives, and MudTools ribs are probably his most used tools. Hardware store tar paper is the best for templates and testing forms.
- Jeremy does not currently have an apprentice, but he has openings for two apprentices for the 2022–2023 year and applications are open.
- He does have a studio assistant that helps with general studio upkeep and maintenance in exchange for studio access.
