This isn't a question but it's related to the topic. When burning screens for print making, we had this trick of laser printing onto regular printer paper and then making the paper translucent using baby oil. It made the process more accessible and there was no visible loss of definition when compared to laser printing on transparency.

yes, the amaco “inks” are underglazes that have the screen printing medium already added. You would just need to dry out your underglazes and add screen printing medium (Kip showed it earlier - it’s from Speedball)

Newsprint paper is what newspapers are printed on. You can buy blank newsprint online or at office supply store.

I have had good results drawing directly on a transparency with a black paint marker

Have you used Mayco Screen thickener, not sure of the name. Seems very easy to thicken underglaze.

What about painting directly on the pot after you have the black screen on it? Does painting on the newsprint save time?

So the black lines will be the top of the design after she transfers it to the clay. Kip would have to paint the colors on the pot first, then apply the black lines. I think that would be fairly difficult to get it to line up properly.

is there a big difference between newsprint and rice paper?

newsprint is made from wood pulp and cheaper, less durable paper. Rice paper is stronger and more expensive. I wouldn't recommend using it for this process.

Do you fire your mugs to 02? And what clay do you use?

She uses Red Rock Red clay from Rocky Mountain Clay and Sedona Red made by AMACO Brent. She glaze fires her work to cone 02.

I take them to cone 6 too but they become less shiny.

I have a cricut cutter...can I use it for stencils?

absolutely! that's what I am planning on doing! :)

Does this slip work on any base clay body?

Are mugs fired at 02 food safe?

Yes, as long as your glaze is food safe. Cone 02 is hotter than Cone 04, but not as hot as Cone 5.

Do you thin the underglazes if so by how much?

what is the brand name of the glazes she is using now? The closed captioning say Umber?

She is using Amaco Velvet Underglazes right now

Can you use white ug instead of white slip as a base

I have my students leave advice for future students and the main one is always don't smell the red underglaze lol

Is that straight underglaze

Yes, those are just underglaze.

Kaitlynn Flanigan

I don't understand... why the base pieces are a little green?

The greenish color you're seeing is the white slip that has dried on the clay. Talc in the wet, unfired state looks gray. I think the camera is just making it look green right now

Ash Neukamm

why do you need slip to apply underglazes in ombre? can't you just apply them directly?

She wants a white background for the colors.

Kaitlynn Flanigan

Why do use the brown clay instead of white clay

it is just her personal preference. You could use a white clay body if you want.

brand of sieve?

talisman - they should have them at most clay suppliers.

is that regular printer paper?

This is the Rite in the Rain paper

Ash Neukamm

Ok, the white rim it's just your style! ;)

Do you have gum in your white slip for this?

It's not clear... You have to spray it some time before or just a little before?

Just a little before you are going to use them.

Adhesive, I mean

You mention underglaze wash but then you said you thicken the underglaze for the ombre. Did I miss something?

Would Tyvek work as well as "Rite in the Rain" paper?

If I do not have a laminator, is there another option for flattening the rite as rain stencil

Since this takes a lot of time you must have to charge a lot for these little tiles.

The laminator? Do you actually laminate it, or use the machine to keep it all flat?

Can you use an engobe instead of a slip to release the transfer?

i save all my UG jars, esp the 4 oz ones and reuse them.

Would you be able to use these transfers on engobe?
