



Workshop from Home with Stephen Phillips Resources for March 7, 2023

- Stephen's studio is located in a 12 x 32-foot storage building.
- He uses three different clay bodies all by Standard Ceramic Supply: Raku clay 239, 182g
 White stoneware with grog, and 710 dark brown clay with grog.
- Stephen bisque fires to cone 04 and glaze fires to cone 5 in oxidation.
- He uses Amaco's Velvet underglazes for decorating, and commercial glazes from Amaco, Mayco, and Coyote Clay.
- His favorite tool is a small rib by Mud Tools and a heat gun.
- Tools needed for the webinar: a regular potters kit, a small rubber rib, and a blow torch or heat gun.
- Occasionally Stephen's goddaughter and one of his sisters assist him in preparing work for glazing and other things in the studio.
