



## Workshop from Home with Angelique Tassistro Resources for December 16, 2025

- Angelique works in a shared studio that is 800 sq ft (243.8 sq m).
- She uses Standard Clay Company’s [563 Clayer White](#) clay body.
- She bisque fires to cone 05 and glaze fires to cone 5.
- Angelique primarily handbuilds her work, often starting with draping a slab of clay over a custom-made slump mold. She then builds up the form with coils before carving intricate scallops using subtractive processes.
- All the colorful designs on Angelique’s pots are made using layered underglazes. She uses a variety of brands from [Amaco Velvets](#), [Mayco Fundamentals](#), [Spectrum Glazes Underglaze](#), and [Speedball Art Underglazes](#).
- She finishes her work with [Amaco’s HF-09 Zinc-Free Clear](#) commercial glaze.
- Angelique has a studio assistant named Maddison Graybill (and she makes amazing work!).
